The participants were very interested and involved, each contributing to the discussion by giving examples of rights that they are entitled to.


Among the programs that are assisted by our men and women include the following:

Jewish Family Services



JFS is an agency based in Clifton, NJ that works in conjunction with Yedei Chesed, offering an array of programs and services that address the community's needs and challenges. The people we support play a part in the smooth running of JFS on a daily basis! The club SEQUOIA seniors group gathers in the JFS Center, which then needs to be converted back into a shul. Our participants have undertaken this big responsibility. Another program helped by PreVoc members is restocking the JFS food pantry, which services over 130 families in the community, providing them with access to kosher food.

Tomchei Shabbos




